Expectations:

As Missouri Hereford Queen you are a representative of our state in and out of the show ring. As a representative of our state, you must be professional at all times. In the show ring, always have a smile or pleasant expression on your face. Please be aware that members of the Missouri Junior Hereford Association will look up to you and members of the Missouri Hereford Association and Hereford Women of Missouri will be keeping an eye on you.

Required Events

As Missouri Hereford Queen, you will be required to attend Missouri Junior Cattlemen's All-Breeds Show, Junior National Hereford Expo, Missouri State Fair, Missouri Hereford Association Field Day, Missouri Hereford Association Annual Meeting and Banquet, Missouri Opportunity Sale and any other events within the state your presence is required.

Due to COVID-19 you will not be required to attend all events in 2020. If you attend any event stated above, it is expected of you to participate fully in all activities at said event.

Outfit Guidelines

As Missouri Hereford Queen, you will be representing the state while you are in the show ring. While in the show ring, you are **required** to wear your tiara and leather state sash. We follow the National Hereford Women outfit guidelines. They are as follows:

Winter Outfits:

Skirts:

· Following the same guidelines as below.

Blouses or Tops:

Following the same guidelines as below.

Blazer:

- Sleeves MUST be at least wrist length with at your sides.
- Solid colors are preferred and complement your top.
 - NO white, cream, tan, beige, or denim.
 - · No shear fabric (see through).
 - No fringe.
 - No sequins.

Boots:

- Boots are recommended.
- Must be free of dirt and dust at the beginning of each day.

Accessories:

- Conservative and modest rule for jewelry in order to complement and not overpower your tiara.
 - Stud or small earrings.
 - Modest necklaces.
- Gloves are required.

Summer Outfits:

Skirts:

- Longer length in a full, pleated, gathered, gored or A-line style.
 - NO straight skirts or skirts with slits.
- Skirt must cover the top of the boot by at least one inch and at least two inches from the ground.
 - They cannot drag the ground.
- Solid colored skirts are preferred.
 - · NO white, cream, tan, beige, or denim.
 - · No shear fabric, (see through).
 - No tulle or fringe, (this includes straight fringe skirts).
 - · No sequins.
- It is strongly encouraged to wear spandex or a skirt slip under your skirt.

Blouses or Tops:

- Prints or plain fabrics are best.
 - · No see-through fabric.
 - No lace, sequins, or rhinestones will be allowed.
 - · No white, cream, tan, beige or denim.
- It must have a cap or longer sleeve.

Vests and Blazer:

- Vest-if it coordinates with skirt and top, it is acceptable.
- Blazer- sleeves MUST be three guarters length.

Boots:

- Boots are recommended.
- Must be free of dirt and dust at the beginning of each day.

Accessories:

- Conservative and modest rule for jewelry in order to complement and not overpower your tiara.
 - · Stud or small earrings.
 - Modest necklaces.

Certain instances you will be allowed to wear a nice blouse or top, jeans and boots with your crown and leather sash. Please talk with Shelby and Anna before each event to coordinate what is appropriate.

Barn Attire:

Bottoms:

- Shorts
 - Must be fingertip length
- Jeans or pants
 - No holes or rips

Tops:

- Short-sleeve t-shirts or nice blouses preferred.
 - · No see-through fabric.
 - No cut-off shirts allowed.

Shoes:

Boots or tennis shoes.
